# ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A40 Trunk Road (Haverfordwest to Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015

Made 12 October 2015

Coming into force 19 October 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London - Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

## **Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 19 October 2015 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Haverfordwest to Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015.

# **2.**—(1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means the lengths of the trunk road between Haverfordwest and Fishguard in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 19 October 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

#### **Restrictions & Prohibition**

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

#### **Suspensions**

**6.** The provisions of The A40 Trunk Road (Withybush, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (40 mph and 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2006(3), The A40 Trunk Road (Scleddau, Pembrokeshire) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2004(4), The A40 Trunk Road (Letterston, Pembrokeshire) (40 mph and 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2002(5) and The A40 Trunk Road (Haverfordwest Bypass, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1994(6) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the relevant lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3 and 4 are in operation.

#### **Application**

**7.** The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

# **Duration of this Order**

**8.** The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

#### **SCHEDULES**

## SCHEDULE 1 Temporary 40 mph or 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 117 metres north of its junction with Scotchwell Roundabout to a point 116 metres south of its junction with Withybush Roundabout, Haverfordwest, including the circulatory carriageway of Cardigan Road Roundabout.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 103 metres north of its junction with Withybush Roundabout, Haverfordwest to its junction with the road leading to Rudbaxton.

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the road leading to Treffgarne to the permanent 40 mph speed limit sign south of Wolfscastle.

The length of the trunk road that extends from the permanent 40 mph speed limit sign north of Wolfscastle to a point 233 metres south of its junction with the B4331.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 217 metres north of its junction with the B4331 to a point 20 metres south of its junction with Manorowen Roundabout, Fishguard.

# SCHEDULE 2 Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with Scotchwell Roundabout, Haverfordwest to a point 117 metres north of the said junction.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 116 metres south of its junction with Withybush Roundabout, Haverfordwest to a point 103 metres north of its junction with the said roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout.

The length of the trunk road that extends from the permanent 40 mph speed limit sign south of Wolfscastle to the permanent 40 mph speed limit sign north of Wolfscastle.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 233 metres south of its junction with the B4331 to a point 217 metres north of the said junction.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 20 metres south of its junction with Manorowen Roundabout, Fishguard to its junction with the said roundabout.
