**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 22,
Old Colwyn to Junction 20,
Brompton Avenue, Conwy)
(Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) Order 2016**

Made 14 March 2016

Coming into force 23 March 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Chester–Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (“the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), hereby make the following Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 23 March 2016. Its title is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 22, Old Colwyn to Junction 20, Brompton Avenue, Conwy) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016.

2. (1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”) means those lengths of the A55 trunk road from Junction 22, Old Colwyn to Junction 20, Brompton Avenue in the County Borough of Conwy specified in the Schedule;

“exempted vehicle” (“cerbyd esempt”) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 23 March 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive, cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

SCHEDULE

1. The length of the main westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point at the nosing of the westbound off slip road at Junction 22, Old Colwyn to the centre-point of Junction 20, Brompton Avenue.

2. The entire lengths of the westbound on-slip roads at Junction 22, Old Colwyn and Junction 21, Victoria Avenue.
