**The A40 Trunk Road (Llandeilo to
Broad Oak, Carmarthenshire)
(Temporary Speed Restrictions &
No Overtaking) Order 2016**

Made 3 June 2016

Coming into force 13 June 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the length of the Llandeilo – Carmarthen Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of a danger to the public and because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 13 June 2016 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Llandeilo to Broad Oak, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

(a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services; and

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and are being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of the member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—

- (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
- (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“*lluoedd arbennig*”) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the length(s) of the trunk road” (“*y darn(au) o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the trunk road between Llandeilo and Broad Oak in the County of Carmarthenshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 13 June 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions & Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules.

Suspensions

6. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of vehicles on the relevant lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules are suspended during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3 and 4 are in operation.

Application

7. (1) The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

(2) No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to an exempted vehicle.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary 40 mph or 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 24 metres west of its junction with Llandeilo Roundabout to its junction with the C2145 at Broad Oak.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with Llandeilo Roundabout to a point 24 metres west of the said junction.
