**The A40 Trunk Road (Junction of
Cross Street and Monk Street,
Abergavenny, Monmouthshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles
& Cyclists) Order 2016**

Made 24 August 2016

Coming into force 31 August 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the length of the Raglan – Llandovery Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 31 August 2016 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Junction of Cross Street and Monk Street, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road at the junction of Cross Street and Monk Street at Abergavenny in the County of Monmouthshire that extends from a point 98 metres north-west of the centre-point of the junction between Cross Street and Mill Street to a point 136 metres south-west of the centre-point of the junction between Monk Street and Lower Monk Street;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 31 August 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the length of the trunk road.

4. No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause any pedal cycle to be ridden in the length of the trunk road.

Application

5. The prohibitions in articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
