**The A487 Trunk Road (Caernarfon
Flyover, Caernarfon, Gwynedd)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2017**

Made 12 December 2017

Coming into force 18 December 2017

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road (A487), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 18 December 2017 and its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Caernarfon Flyover, Caernarfon, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2017.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the Fishguard to Bangor trunk road (A487) at Caernarfon in the County of Gwynedd;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 09:30 hours on 18 December 2017 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(1) 1984 c.27; section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1. By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 200 meters south of the centre-point of its intersection with Alexandra Roundabout to a point 120 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with Rhes Cwstenin.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
