The Commons Act 2006 (Commencement  
No. 4) (Wales) Order 2017

9 April 2017

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred upon the appropriate national authority by section 56(1) of the Commons Act 2006<sup>(1)</sup>:

**Title, interpretation and application**

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Commons Act 2006 (Commencement No. 4) (Wales) Order 2017.

(2) In this Order—

“the 1965 Act” (“*Deddf 1965*”) means the Commons Registration Act 1965<sup>(2)</sup>; and

“the 2006 Act” (“*Deddf 2006*”) means the Commons Act 2006.

(3) This Order applies in relation to Wales.

**Provisions coming into force**

2. The following provisions of the 2006 Act come into force on 10 April 2017—

(a) section 19(1) to (5) and (7) (correction); and

(b) paragraphs 1, 2(1) and (2)(a) to (c), 3(1) and (2)(a) to (d), 4(1) to (5), 5(1), 5(2), 6(1), 6(2), 7(1), 7(2), 8(1), 8(2) and 9(1) to (3) of Schedule 2 (non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act).

**Provisions coming into force for all remaining purposes**

3. The following provisions of the 2006 Act come into force for all remaining purposes on 10 April 2017—

(a) section 19(6) (correction);

(b) section 22 (non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act); and

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order brings into force on 10 April 2017 section 19 (correction) and section 22 of (non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act) and Schedule 2 (non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act) to the Commons Act 2006 (“the 2006 Act”) in relation to Wales.

Article 2 of this Order brings into force the provisions of the 2006 Act cited in that article.

Article 3 of this Order brings into force for all remaining purposes provisions which relate to correction and non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act.
