

**2018 No. 189 (W. 40)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A40 Trunk Road (Park Road  
and Hereford Road, Abergavenny,  
Monmouthshire) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Vehicles &  
Pedestrians) Order 2018**

*Made* 5 February 2018

*Coming into force* 12 February 2018

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the A40 Raglan to Llandovery Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

**1.** The title of this Order is The A40 Trunk Road (Park Road and Hereford Road, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Pedestrians) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 12 February 2018.

**2.** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A40 Raglan to Llandovery Trunk Road and footways as follows:

- i. The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 15 metres east of the centre point of the junction of Park Avenue and Park Road to a point 145 metres south of the centre point of the junction of Hereford Road and Park Road;
- ii. The length of the footway on the northern side of the trunk road known as Park Road that extends from a point 5 metres east of the centre point of Bailey Park entrance to its junction with Hereford Road in an easterly direction; and
- iii. The length of the footway on the western side of the trunk road known as Hereford Road that extends from its junction with Park Road to its junction with Lion Street in a southerly direction.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 12 February 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

### **Prohibitions**

**3.** No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, to proceed on the length of the trunk road.

**4.** No person may, during the works period, proceed along the lengths of the footway.

### **Application**

**5.** The prohibitions of article 3 and 4 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

**6.** The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.
