

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A4060 East of Abercynon to East of Dowlais trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 12 February 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

Application

6. The prohibitions of articles 3, 4 and 5 may apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

1. The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the north-eastern side of Abercanaid Roundabout to its junction with the south-eastern side of Pentrebach Roundabout.
2. The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the north-eastern side of Pentrebach Roundabout to its junction with the southern side of Leo's Roundabout.
3. The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the northern side of Leo's Roundabout to its junction with the southern side of Mountain Hare Roundabout.
4. The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the northern side of Mountain Hare Roundabout to its junction with the southern side of Dowlais Roundabout.
