**The A483 Trunk Road (West Street,
Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2018**

Made 1 May 2018

Coming into force 8 May 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A483 Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (West Street, Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 8 May 2018.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A483 Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:30 hours on 8 May 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed westbound on the length of the trunk road known as West Street, Builth Wells, Powys that extends from a point 10 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Market Street to a point 5 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Smithfield Road.

Suspension

4. The provisions of the Trunk Road (A483) (Builth Wells, Powys) (One Way Traffic) Order 1983(2) are suspended in respect of the lengths of the trunk road known as High Street, Church Street and West Street during such times as the prohibition specified in article 3 of this Order is in operation.

Application

5. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
