**The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads at
Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike), Isle of
Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition
of Vehicles) Order 2018**

Made 4 May 2018

Coming into force 11 May 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 London to Holyhead Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads at Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 11 May 2018.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 London to Holyhead trunk road on the Isle of Anglesey;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 18:00 hours on 11 May 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of the eastbound or westbound exit and entry slip roads of the trunk road at Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike).

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.
