The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 45B and 45P(2) of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984(1), make the following Regulations.

#### Title and coming into force

**1.**—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Health Protection (Coronavirus, International Travel) (Wales) (Amendment) (No. 14) Regulations 2021.

(2) These Regulations come into force at 7.59 p.m. on 26 November 2021.

## Revocation

**2.** The Health Protection (Coronavirus, International Travel) (Wales) (Amendment) (No. 13) Regulations 2021(**2**) are revoked.
