 - (2) From 1 September 2022, the 2013 Order does not apply to
 - (a) children and pupils—
 - (i) receiving nursery education in a maintained nursery school or a maintained school, or
 - (ii) receiving funded non-maintained nursery education,
 - (b) pupils in their reception year, and
 - (c) pupils in years 1 to 6.
- (3) On 1 September 2023, the 2013 Order does not apply to pupils in year 7 at a maintained school where the head teacher and governing body have adopted a relevant curriculum for those year 7 pupils under Part 2 of the 2021 Act.
- (4) From 1 September 2023, the 2013 Order does not apply to pupils in years 7 or 8 at a maintained school.
 - (5) The 2013 Order is revoked on 1 September 2024.
