**The A458 Trunk Road (Broad
Street & High Street, Welshpool,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) (No. 2) Order 2023**

Made 27 April 2023

Coming into force 6 May 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of a relevant event, namely a celebration of the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III, being held on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Broad Street & High Street, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) (No. 2) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 6 May 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“event period” (“*cyfnod y digwyddiad*”) means that period commencing at 12:00 hours on 6 May 2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (i) any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance services purposes;
- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or

traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned;

- (iii) any vehicle used by an authorised event official in support of and for reasons of the safety of the relevant event;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the event period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as Broad Street and High Street at Welshpool, Powys that extends from its junction with The Cross to the southern tip of the splitter island at its junction with Jehu Road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 1 day.
