ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A487 Trunk Road (Aberarth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of a Left Hand Turn) Order 2023

Made 29 June 2023

Coming into force 10 July 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Aberarth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of a Left Hand Turn) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 10 July 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 21:00 hours on the 10 July

2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, permit any vehicle to make a left hand turn from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road on to the C1056 county road at Aberarth, Ceredigion.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.
