The A487 Trunk Road (Trefechan,
Aberystwyth, Ceredigion)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2024

Made 23 February 2024

Coming into force 4 March 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A487 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Trefechan, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 4 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on

4 March 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the named trunk road also known as Penparcau Road, that extends from a point 100 metres south-east of the centre-point of its junction with Gerddi Rheidol in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 360 metres to the southern approach to Trefechan Bridge at Trefechan, Aberystwyth.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
