ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A48 Trunk Road (East of Nantycaws, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Righthand Turn) Order 2024

Made	26 February 2024
Coming into force	2 March 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A48 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A48 Trunk Road (East of Nantycaws, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 2 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("*y gefnffordd*") means the A48 London to Fishguard trunk road;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 2 March

2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, permit any vehicle to proceed in the A48 eastbound dedicated right-turn lane into the recycling centre and landfill site east of Nantycaws, Carmarthenshire.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order is 12 months.
