**The A470 Trunk Road (South
Street, Rhayader, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles
& Cyclists) Order 2024**

Made 8 March 2024

Coming into force 14 March 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (South Street, Rhayader, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 14 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A470 Cardiff to Llangurig trunk road known as South Street, Rhayader that extends from a point 10 metres north-west of the centre-point of its junction with the road leading to Bryn Gwy

Estate to its junction with the A44 East Street, Rhayader, Powys;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 14 March 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2.

Application

5. The prohibitions in articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
