**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A483 Trunk Road (Broad  
Street & High Street, Builth Wells,  
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of  
Vehicles) Order 2024**

*Made* 8 April 2024

*Coming into force* 15 April 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A483 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>, make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (Broad Street & High Street, Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 15 April 2024.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“y gefnffordd”) means the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road;

“works period” (“cyfnod y gwaith”) means intermittent periods commencing at 22:00 hours on 15 April 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Suspension**

5. The provisions of the Trunk Road (A483) (Builth Wells, Powys) (One Way Traffic) Order 1983(1) are hereby suspended in respect of the lengths of the trunk road known as The Strand, Church Street and West Street during such times as the prohibition specified in article 3 of this Order is in operation.

### **Duration of this Order**

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

## **SCHEDULE**

The length of the trunk road known as Broad Street, Builth Wells that extends from a point 10 metres west of its junction with the A470 Castle Street to the centre-point of its junction with King's Head Lane.

The length of the trunk road known as High Street, Builth Wells that extends from the centre-point of its junction with King's Head Lane to a point 3 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Strand Street.

The length of the trunk road known as High Street, Builth Wells that extends from a point 3 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Strand Street to a point 3 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Market Street.
