ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36 (Warren Interchange) to the Wales/England Border, Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2024

Made 30 April 2024

Coming into force 8 May 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36 (Warren Interchange) to the Wales/England Border, Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 8 May 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A55 Chester to Bangor trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 21:00 on 8 May 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.

SCHEDULE

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians

- 1. The length of the A55 eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 36 (Warren Interchange) in an easterly direction to the Wales/England border.
- 2. The entire length of the A55 eastbound entry slip road at Junction 36 (Warren Interchange).
- 3. The entire length of the A55 eastbound entry slip road at Junction 36A (Broughton).
- 4. The length of the A55 westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the Wales/England border in a westerly direction to the nosing of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 36 (Warren Interchange).
- 5. The entire length of the A55 westbound exit slip road at Junction 36 (Warren Interchange).
- 6. The entire length of the A55 westbound exit slip road at Junction 36A (Broughton).
