ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A483 Trunk Road (Cilyrychen Level Crossing, Llandybie, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made 3 May 2024

Coming into force 12 May 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A483 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (Cilyrychen Level Crossing, Llandybie, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 12 May 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 21:40 hours on 12 May 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road at Llandeilo Road, Llandybie, Carmarthenshire that extends from a point 40 metres north-east of Cilyrychen level crossing to a point 40 metres south-west of the level crossing.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.
