ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A487 Trunk Road (Dinas Cross, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made	22 January 2024
Coming into force	28 January 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1), (4) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Dinas Cross, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 28 January 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("*cerbyd esempt*") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("*y gefnffordd*") means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 28 January 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road at Dinas Cross, Pembrokeshire that extends from a point 20 metres north of its junction with Bryngelli to a point 170 metres south of the centre-point of its junction with the road leading to Cae Tabor.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Revocation

5. The A487 Trunk Road (Dinas Cross, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023(1) is revoked.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
