



# A Statute Concerning Tallage (1297)

1297 CHAPTER 1 25 Edw 1

## I No Tallage or Aid without Assent of Parliament.

No Tallage or Aid shall be [<sup>X1</sup>taken] or levied by Us or our Heirs in our Realm, without the good will and Assent of (<sup>X2</sup>) Archbishops, Bishops, Earls, Barons, Knights, Burgesses, and other [<sup>X3</sup>Freemen of the Land.]
