1558 CHAPTER 1 1 Eliz 1

VIII All Spiritual Jurisdiction united to the Crown.

AND That suche Jurisdictions Privileges Superiorities and Preheminences Spirituall and Ecclesiasticall, as by any Spirituall or Ecclesiasticall Power or Auctorite hathe heretofore bene or may lawfully be exercised or used for the Visitacion of the Ecclesiasticall State and Persons, and for Reformatiō Order and Correccion of the same and of all maner of Errours Heresies Scismes Abuses Offences Contemptes and Enormities, shall for ever by auctorite of this present Parliament be united and annexed to the Imperiall Crowne of this Realme: . . . ^{F1}
