## CHAPTER 10

### HOUSE OF LORDS PRECEDENCE ACT 1539

- None but the King's Children shall sit on either Side of the Cloth of Estate in Parliament.
- II Place of the King's Ecclesiastical Vicegerent; above the Archbishop of Canterbury.
  - III Places of the Archbishops and Bishops.
  - IV Places of the Lord Chancellor, Lord Treasurer, Lord President of the Council, Lord Privy Seal.
  - V Places of Lords Great Chamberlain, Constable, Marshal, Admiral, Steward, King's Chamberlain.
  - VI Place of the King's Chief Secretary.
  - VII All Nobility according to seniority.
  - VIII Places of the Chancellor, &c. if under the Degree of Barons.
  - IX .....
  - X Places of Great Officers in the Star Chamber, or in other Councils.
