TRANSITIONAL AND TRANSITORY PROVISIONS AND SAVINGS

Temporary reduction of maximum penalty for either way offence tried summarily

9 In the case of an offence committed before [<sup>F1</sup>2 May 2022], section 43(3)(a) has effect as if for "[<sup>F2</sup>the general limit in a magistrates’ court]" there were substituted “ 6 months ”.
