10 **Review of operation of Act**

The Welsh Ministers must, not later than 31 July 2016, review the operation of this Act with a view in particular to assessing its impact on—

- the funding of education provided at further education institutions in Wales for students who are above compulsory school age but have not attained the age of 19,
- Welsh language provision at such institutions, and (b)
- additional learning needs provision at such institutions.

11 Commencement

- (1) Section 9, this section and section 12 come into force on the day on which this Act receives Royal Assent.
- (2) The other provisions of this Act come into force on such day as the Welsh Ministers may appoint by order made by statutory instrument.
- (3) An order under this section may
 - appoint different days for different purposes;
 - contain transitional, transitory or saving provision in connection with the coming into force of this Act.
