XI Slaying Lords of Session sitting in Judgment, Treason.

And if any Person shall . . . $^{\rm F1}$ slay any of the Lords of Session Lords of Justiciary sitting in Judgment in the Exercise of their Office within Scotland the doing thereof shall be construed adjudged and taken to be High Treason
