



Criminal Law Amendment Act (Northern Ireland) 1923

1923 CHAPTER 8

3 Amendment of penalties under s.13 of principal Act.

Any person who is convicted of an offence against section thirteen^{F1} of the principal Act (which relates to summary proceedings against brothel keepers, &c.) shall be liable on summary conviction—

- (a) to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to imprisonment. ...^{F2} for a term not exceeding three months; and
 - (b) on a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds or to imprisonment. ...^{F2} for a term not exceeding six months;
- or, in any such case, to both fine and imprisonment.
