1924 CHAPTER 24

An Act to make provision for the permanent adoption in Northern Ireland of the Time adopted for use in Great Britain. [7th November 1924]

WHEREAS it is expedient that provision should be made that the time for general purposes in Northern Ireland should at all times be the same as the time for general purposes in Great Britain:
