1924 CHAPTER 24

1 Time in Northern Ireland.

Any enactment of the Parliament of the United Kingdom or Order of His Majesty in Council passed or made after the passing of this Act and for the time being in force, which makes or continues any provisions with respect to the time for general purposes in Great Britain, shall apply, with respect to the time for general purposes in Northern Ireland, to the extent to which it applies in Great Britain, and during the same periods in any year, and subject to the same limitations, as may be for the time being in force for or with respect to the adoption of such time in Great Britain; and the Time (Ireland) Act, 1916, shall, as respects Northern Ireland, have effect accordingly.
