An Act to provide for the humane and scientific slaughter of animals; and for purposes connected therewith. [7th June 1932]

3 Employment of slaughtermen by local authority. N.I.

Any local authority which have provided or established a slaughter-house may, if they think fit, employ persons to slaughter or stun animals,^{F1}... and may make such charges as they consider reasonable for the services of the persons so employed.

9 Interpretation. N.I.

For the purpose of this Act the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

"Slaughter-house" means any building, premises or place used in connection with the business of killing animals for the purpose of the flesh being used as butcher's meat;

"Animal" means any horse, mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly, stallion, ass, donkey, mule, bull, cow, bullock, heifer, calf, steer, ox, sheep, ewe, wether, ram, lamb, goat, kid, [^{F3} pig, boar, hog or sow];
