

Hairdressers Act (Northern Ireland) 1939

1939 CHAPTER 3

4 **Prosecution of offences.**

- (1) All offences under this Act shall be prosecuted, and all fines thereunder shall be recovered, in manner provided by the Summary Jurisdiction Acts (Northern Ireland); and a person aggrieved by a conviction or order made by a court of summary jurisdiction on determining any information or complaint under this Act may appeal in manner provided by the said Summary Jurisdiction Acts.
- (2) Prosecutions for offences under this Act or against any byelaw made thereunder may be instituted by an officer of the [^{F1} district council] authorised in that behalf by the [^{F1} council] or by any member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary acting within the district of the [^{F1} council].
