##### VENUE

#### 7 Venue in indictable offences.

<sup>F1</sup>(1) A person charged with the commission in Northern Ireland of any indictable offence [<sup>F2</sup> or with the commission of an indictable offence cognisable under the law of Northern Ireland] may be proceeded against, indicted, tried and punished in any ...<sup>F3</sup> place in which he was apprehended, or is in custody on a charge for the offence or has appeared in answer to a summons lawfully issued charging the offence, as if the offence had been committed in that ...<sup>F3</sup> place, and the offence shall, for all purposes incidental to or consequential on the prosecution, trial or punishment thereof, be deemed to have been committed in that ...<sup>F3</sup> place:

(3) Nothing in this section shall affect the laws relating to the government of His Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
