VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND INDUSTRIAL REHABILITATION COURSES

## 4 F<sup>1</sup>Payments to persons attending courses.

The Ministry, or, in the case of a course provided by, or under arrangements made by, another government department, that department, may defray, or contribute towards, expenses incurred by persons attending vocational training courses or industrial rehabilitation courses in travelling to and from the place where the course is held, and may make payments to or in respect of such persons, up to such amounts as the Ministry or that department may with the approval of the Ministry of Finance determine and in such manner as the Ministry or that department may determine.
