PART V

TIMES OF FISHING AND ANCILLARY PROVISIONS

28 Fishing during close seasons.

If any person-

- (a) fishes for, takes, kills or attempts to take or kill salmon or trout [^{F1}or any other fish of a kind prescribed for the purposes of this section](except with a rod and line), during the annual close season, or
- (b) fishes for, takes, kills or attempts to take or kill salmon or trout [^{F1}or any other fish of a kind prescribed for the purposes of this section] with a rod and line during the annual close season for angling, or
- (c) aids or assists in any such act or attempt,

he shall be guilty of an offence against this Act.
