[^{F1}41 Re-settlement etc., of persons convicted of offences.

- (1) The [^{F2}Department] may make and give effect to such schemes as [^{F3}the Department] may think expedient for the supervision or assistance of persons serving a sentence of imprisonment or detained in a young offenders centre with a view to their resettlement and rehabilitation.
- (2) The [^{F2}Department] may make grants towards the expenditure of any society which is engaged in assisting persons convicted of offences with a view to their resettlement and rehabilitation.]
