



Common Informers Act (Northern Ireland) 1954

1954 CHAPTER 11

2 Application to the Crown.

Sub-section (1) of section one of this Act shall bind the Crown so as to prevent the Crown from bringing proceedings as a common informer and, accordingly, the reference to a common informer in that sub-section shall include a reference to the Crown acting as a common informer.
