OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

27 Forgery of passport.

- (1) ^{F1} If any person ^{F2} . . . makes a statement which is to his knowledge untrue for the purpose of procuring a passport whether for himself or any other person he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable—
- (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for any term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding [^{F3} level 3 on the standard scale] or to both such imprisonment and fine;
 - (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for any term not exceeding two years or to [^{F3} an unlimited fine] or to both such imprisonment and fine.
