#### SUPERANNUATION

##### SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

#### 128 Persons serving again after retirement.

Where any person after retirement resumes<sup>F1</sup> . . . service, that retirement shall be left out of account for all the purposes of sections one hundred and twenty-one to one hundred and thirty-three except that—

- (a) if a lump sum was granted on that retirement without any contribution being made, then unless that person on resumption of<sup>F1</sup> . . . service, or within three months of<sup>F1</sup> . . . marrying<sup>F2</sup> or forming a civil partnership] while again serving, refunds [<sup>F3</sup> to the Consolidated Fund of the United Kingdom] by way of contribution one-half of the lump sum, no pension shall be granted to any<sup>F1</sup> widow, widower<sup>F2</sup>, surviving civil partner] or child of that person]; and
- (b) any lump sum granted on that retirement, less any refund, shall be set off against any lump sum to be granted in respect of<sup>F1</sup> that person's] service.
