JUDGES AND DEPUTY JUDGES

[^{F1}106 Salaries and allowances of judges.

- (1) There shall be paid to each judge such salary as may be determined by the Lord Chancellor with the consent of [^{F2} the Treasury].
- (2) The salary payable to any judge shall begin from the date on which the judge takes the [^{F3} required oath or makes the required affirmation and declaration].
- [^{F4}(3) The Department of Justice may pay to any judge such allowances as may be determined by the Lord Chancellor with the consent of the Treasury.]
