1960 CHAPTER 2

RETIREMENT AND PENSION

1 Retiring age of resident magistrates.

Every resident magistrate (whether appointed before or after the passing of this Act) shall vacate his office on the day on which he attains the age of seventy; but this section is subject to section 26(4) to (6) of the Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993 (^{F1} Lord Chancellor's power to authorise continuance in office up to the age of 75).
