SCHEDULE

CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH A CARAVAN SITE LICENCE IS NOT REQUIRED

BUILDING AND ENGINEERING SITES

- Subject to paragraph 13, a site licence shall not be required for the use as a caravan site of land which forms part of, or adjoins, land on which building or engineering operations are being carried out (being operations for the carrying out of which permission[F1 under [F2the Planning Act] has], if required, been granted) if that use is for the accommodation of a person or persons employed in the course of those operations or the person or persons who own any estate in the land on which those operations are being carried out.
