APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF RESIDENT MAGISTRATES

[F19 Appointment and assignment of resident magistrates.

- (1) Her Majesty may, on the recommendation of the Lord Chancellor, appoint fit and proper persons to be resident magistrates, being persons who at the dates of their appointments [F2] are—
 - (a) members of the Bar of Northern Ireland of at least seven years' standing; or
 - (b) solicitors of the Supreme Court of at least seven years' standing.]

- (3) A resident magistrate shall sit in accordance with directions given by the [F3Lord Chief Justice].
- (4) A resident magistrate may, in accordance with such directions, sit in any petty sessions district.
- (5) Subject to subsections (3) and (4), the [F3Lord Chief Justice] may assign a resident magistrate to one or more petty sessions districts and may from time to time vary any such assignment.]

10 Appointment of deputy resident magistrates.

- (1) ^{F4}The [F5 Lord Chancellor] may, ... F6, appoint fit and proper persons, [F5 being persons who are eligible for appointment as F7, or have previously been, resident magistrates], to act as deputy resident magistrates during such period or periods as F4 the [F5 Lord Chancellor] may direct and subject to F4 such conditions as the [F5 Lord Chancellor] may impose.
- (2) Any deputy resident magistrate may exercise and perform all the functions of a resident magistrate.
