# 10 Appointment of deputy resident magistrates.

- (1) F1The [F2 Lord Chancellor] may, ... F3, appoint fit and proper persons, [F2 being persons who are eligible for appointment as F4, or have previously been, resident magistrates], to act as deputy resident magistrates during such period or periods as F1 the [F2 Lord Chancellor] may direct and subject to F1 such conditions as the [F2 Lord Chancellor] may impose.
- (2) Any deputy resident magistrate may exercise and perform all the functions of a resident magistrate.
