APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF RESIDENT MAGISTRATES

10 Appointment of deputy resident magistrates.

- (1) ^{F1}The [^{F2} Lord Chancellor] may, ... ^{F3}, appoint fit and proper persons, [^{F2} being persons who are eligible for appointment as^{F4}, or have previously been, resident magistrates], to act as deputy resident magistrates during such period or periods as^{F1} the [^{F2} Lord Chancellor] may direct and subject to^{F1} such conditions as the [^{F2} Lord Chancellor] may impose.
- (2) Any deputy resident magistrate may exercise and perform all the functions of a resident magistrate.
