### PART VI

#### EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN, YOUNG PERSONS AND CHILDREN

##### PROHIBITION OF EMPLOYMENT OF CHILDREN AND OF WOMEN AFTER CHILDBIRTH

#### **84 Prohibition of employment of children.**

- (1) A child shall not be employed in any factory.
- (2) In this Act “child” means a person who has not attained the upper limit of compulsory school age within the meaning of [<sup>F1</sup> Article 36 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972].

#### **85 Prohibition of employment of women after childbirth.**

An occupier of a factory shall not knowingly allow a woman or girl to be employed therein within four weeks after she has given birth to a child.
