166 Definitions for purposes of Part XI.

(1) In this Part—

“authorised person” means^{[F1} (except where otherwise provided)] a person being—

- (a) a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, or
- (b) an officer appointed by the Ministry, or
- (c) ^{F2}

(2) In sections 174 to 177, 179, 184 and 185 the expression “authorised person” includes—

- (a) any British sea-fishery officer,^{F4}...

(3) In subsection (2) “British sea-fishery officer” means [^{F5} any person who is such an officer for the purposes of the Sea Fisheries Acts (as defined by section 19(1) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968).]
