1968 CHAPTER 28

9 Riotous, disorderly and indecent behaviour, etc.

[^{F1}(1) Any person—

- (a) guilty of any indecent behaviour in any street, road, highway or other public place, or in any place to which the public have access (whether as of right or by permission and whether subject to or free of charge); or]

, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding [^{F2} level 3 on the standard scale], or to both.
