



Protection of the Person and Property Act (Northern Ireland) 1969

1969 CHAPTER 29

2 Making or possessing petrol bombs, etc.

Any person who makes, or has in his possession, any apparatus, instrument, article or thing which—

- (a) contains any inflammable liquid or substance; or
- (b) is constructed or adapted for use in conjunction with any such liquid or substance so as to cause injury or loss of life to any person or damage to any property;

under such circumstances as to give rise to a reasonable suspicion that he is not making it or does not have it in his possession for a lawful object shall, unless he can show that he made it or had it in his possession for a lawful object, be guilty of an offence under this section.
