### PART XII

#### OFFENCES, PENALTIES AND LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

#### 140 Removal or defacement of notices, &c.

If, without reasonable excuse, a person removes, ...<sup>F1</sup>

- (a) a notice which is for the time being posted at a mine in pursuance of any provision of this Act or regulations; or
- (b) a document which, in pursuance of section 114, is for the time being provided in accommodation provided in pursuance of that section;

he shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding<sup>F2</sup> level 1 on the standard scale] .
